The 2010 Ultra4 Grand Slam Series began earlier this year with the 2011 King of the Hammers, then BITD Bilek Racing Silver State 300. The team arrived at King of the Hammers fresh off an in class win the BITD Parker 425. Crossing the starting line at KOH with a car having just raced one of the longest races in the states, the team was aware they brought a wounded car to the hardest race there was. A relaxed pace, and a goal of finishing was the plan. And it was achieved. Two months later, At the BITD Silver State 300, which was a key race for the team, As it contained point's for both the BITD series and the Grand Slam

series. The team gave 100% this time, and with only one issue, was able to secure a 4th place in class finish.

While being struck with adversity after the Silver State 300, having our Ultra4 car burn to the ground, Team driver Dave Schneider was quoted as saying "We started off our season in a blaze of glory, and we thought it had ended in a ball of flames, Though with the help of fellow Ultra4 race Jason Conover stepping up, and teaming with RDR for the remainder of the 2010 season, we're back, and better than ever!"

With only days before the CHCA Lands' End Hill Climb the anxiety is high, as this is a new form of racing for the team. Co-Driver Tim Priess was quoted as saying "I'm not sure I like the idea of drifting turns at 70+mph with a thousand foot drop only feet away, But I think Dave can handle it". Trent Fabrication has been hard at work preparing the car to meet the CHCA safety requirements.
